Deacon Harold has given multiple lectures, retreats and seminars and has appeared on the U.S. national radio program Catholic Answers Live, and has been featured on the Eternal Word Television Network (EWTN) and the Trinity Broadcast Network (TBN). He hosts the weekly program "Faith and Life" on Catholic radio in Oregon.

His full time job is that of Director of Public Safety at University of Portland and he is happily married with 4 children.

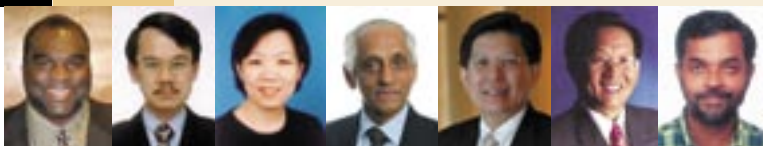

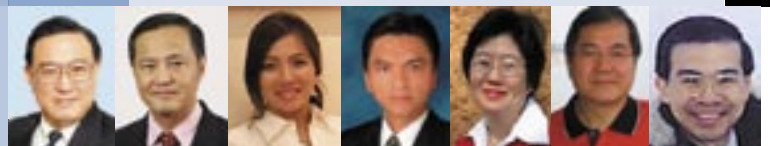
